Final logo could be a combination of elements from those submitted.
Depending on the number of submissions received, winners will be determined by either the general committee if there are a manageable number of submissions; otherwise a select group may review and forward the best submissions to the general committee for the selection of the winners.

Logo guidelines:

Name "Thornton Veterans' Memorial Foundation" should be included.
It should be colorful, patriotic, respectful and should be (past, present and future) veteran related.

Action items for the contest are:

Write copy and get into the local newspapers as soon as possible.

Get permission from organizations we represent to use the organizations' names in the "advertising" of the logo contest.

Get donations of cash or prizes.

Contact public relations people for ideas.
