6. Guest, Jan Kiehl showed flyer to solicit veterans information. It will be on the web, in water bills, and passed out by this organization.
7. Tony Hake reported that everything is on the website. If you need help or cannot find something, let Tony know.
8. Greg Banks has been in communication with Diane and Kristen. He is waiting to hear if we are submitting together or separately. Diane said we need to hire a Civil Engineer for our part of the project.
9. Monument with each branch symbol, center flag poles, five sided with images, rather than globe. Raised pentagon with text on it. Bronze statues are very expensive. Bob Heller suggested using large pieces of flagstone so they don't look like tombstones. He met with a person from the Veteran's of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century and exchanged contact information.
